




REPLACING THE BATTERIES

The batteries included are for demonstration. It is recommended that, prior to playing, an adult install fresh alkaline batteries. Here's how:

- 1. Using a Phillips screwdriver (not included), remove the screw and battery compartment cover located inside the inflatable pet on the backside of the base.
- 2. Install four (4) fresh 1.5V AA (LR6) alkaline batteries (not included) making sure the (+) and (-) ends face the proper direction as indicated on the battery compartment cover.
- 3. Replace the compartment cover by inserting the tab on the side of the cover into the slot first and then press down on the cover and tighten the screw.


- Never throw any objects into the spinning motor.
- Keep long hair tied back and loose apparel away from the spinning motor.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- To prevent batteries from dying, always switch the button to "off" after use.
- Do not leave contents in the sun or in very hot areas.

UNBOXING

• PLASTIC TAGS AND BLISTER REMOVAL: It is recommended that an adult carefully cut the plastic tags holding the blister in place: at the base of the doll stand; around the doll's waist; and behind the doll's head - see examples below (scissors not included); discard plastic tags and blister in a recyclable bin.








KEYLOCK

- 1. Keylocks are located underneath the inflatable base. Turn counterclockwise to unlock.
- 2. Pull the keylock out and discard.
- 3. The inflatable base can now be easily removed from the packaging.











DOLL STAND

Insert the doll stand with the tabs facing towards the back of the base (see step 2). You may damage the doll stand if you try inserting with the tabs facing forward. The doll may not be fully secure if the doll stand is not in place correctly.









INFLATING YOUR PET







Flip the switch under the inflatable base from the "Off" to "On" position.



Watch your pet inflate! Pro Tip: Gently adjust the pet's ears or feet as needed.
